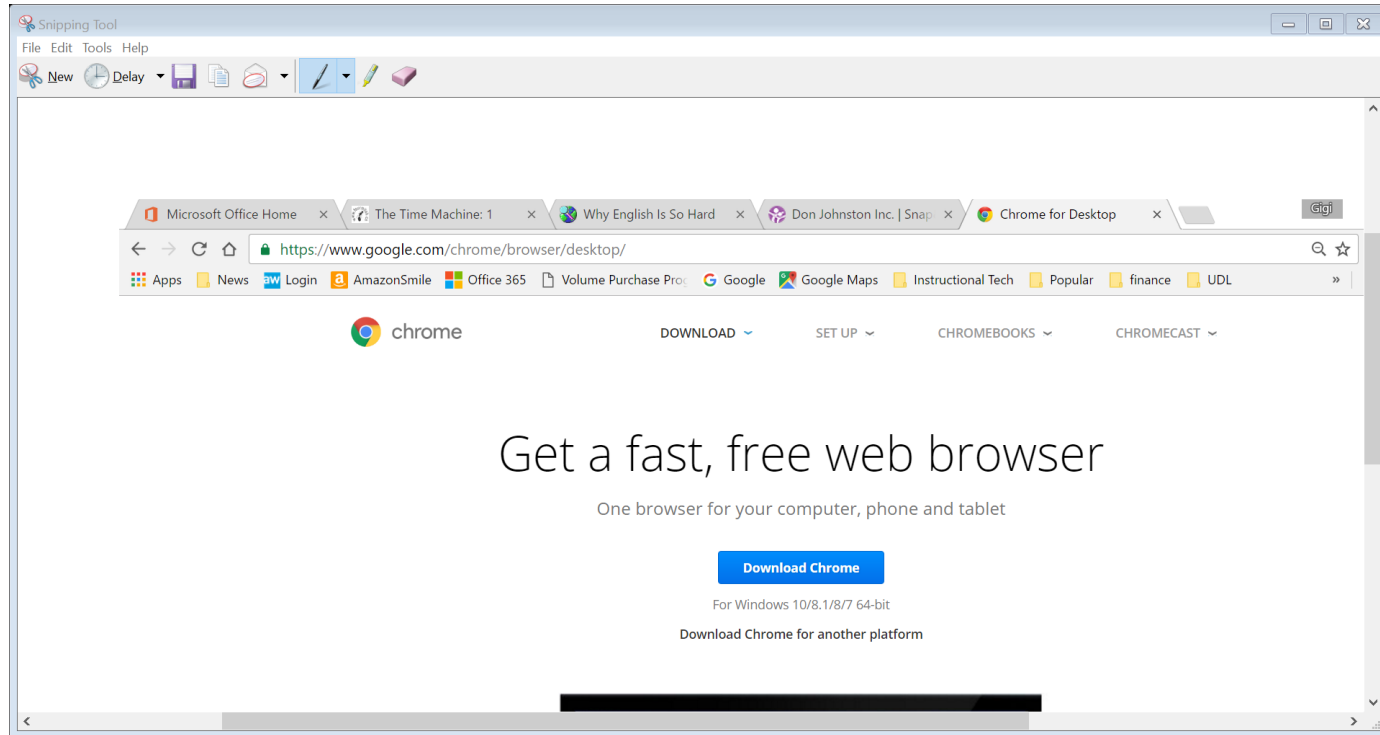



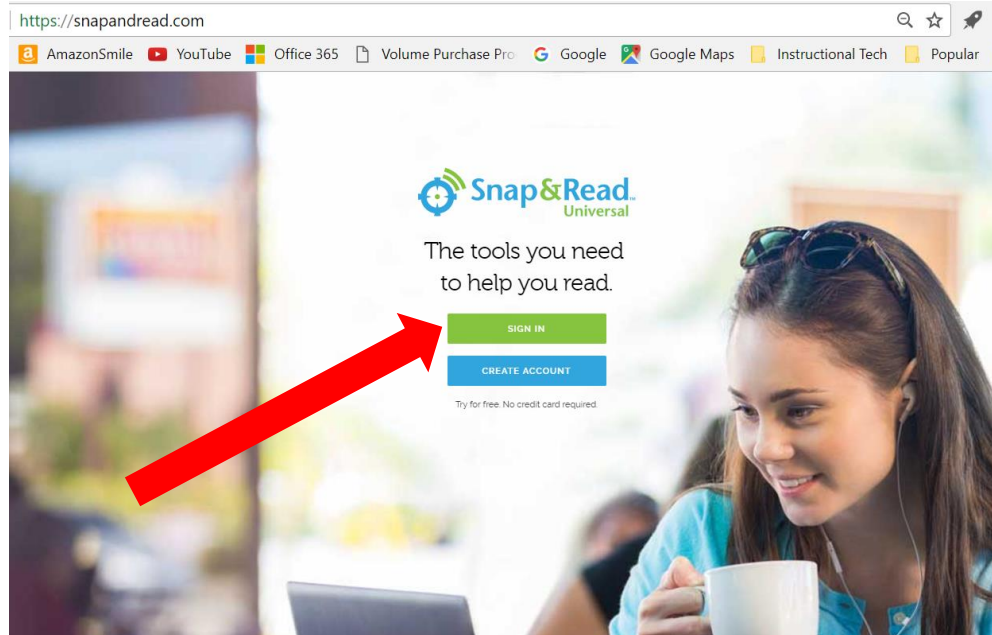

- Right click on extension for “Options” window to open
- Gives 3rd toggle option in text leveler to lower complexity word in native language.
- Must download more voices in speech options in windows as Google voices do not work

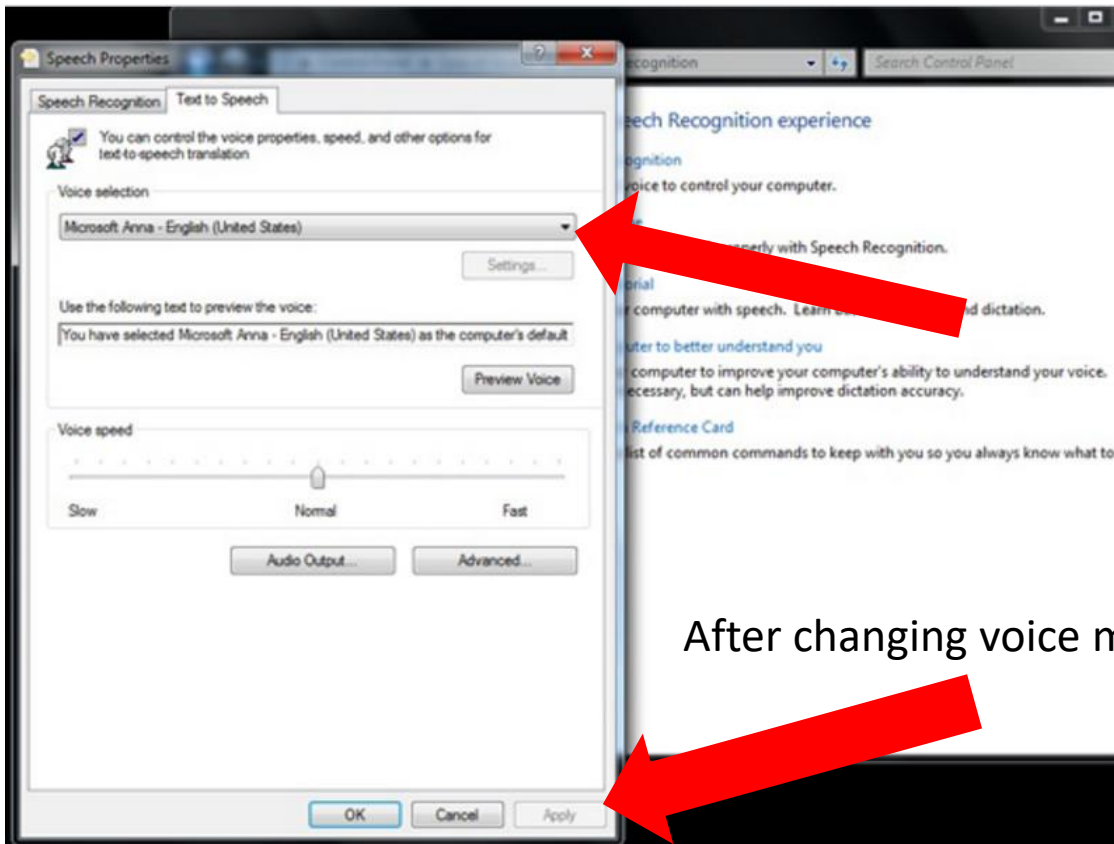

- In search window (bottom left of desktop) – type “speech settings”
- Select “change text to speech settings”
- Use drop down and select Microsoft Anna (probably is set on Microsoft Mary)

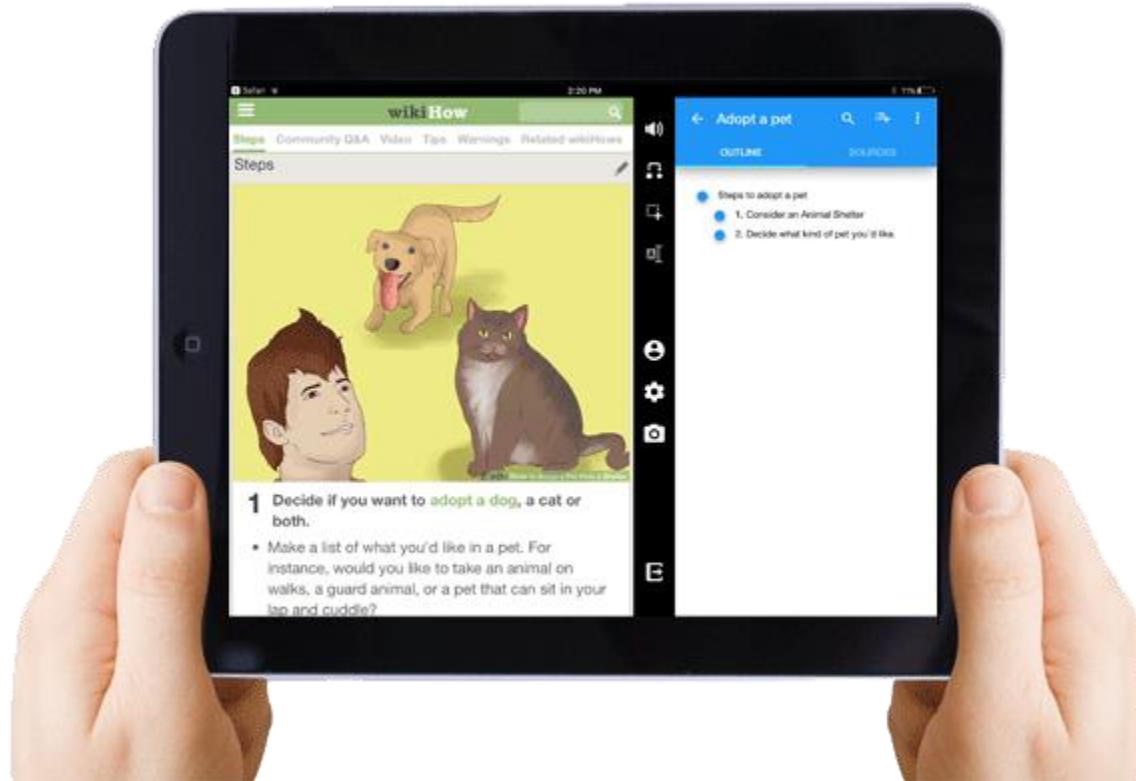



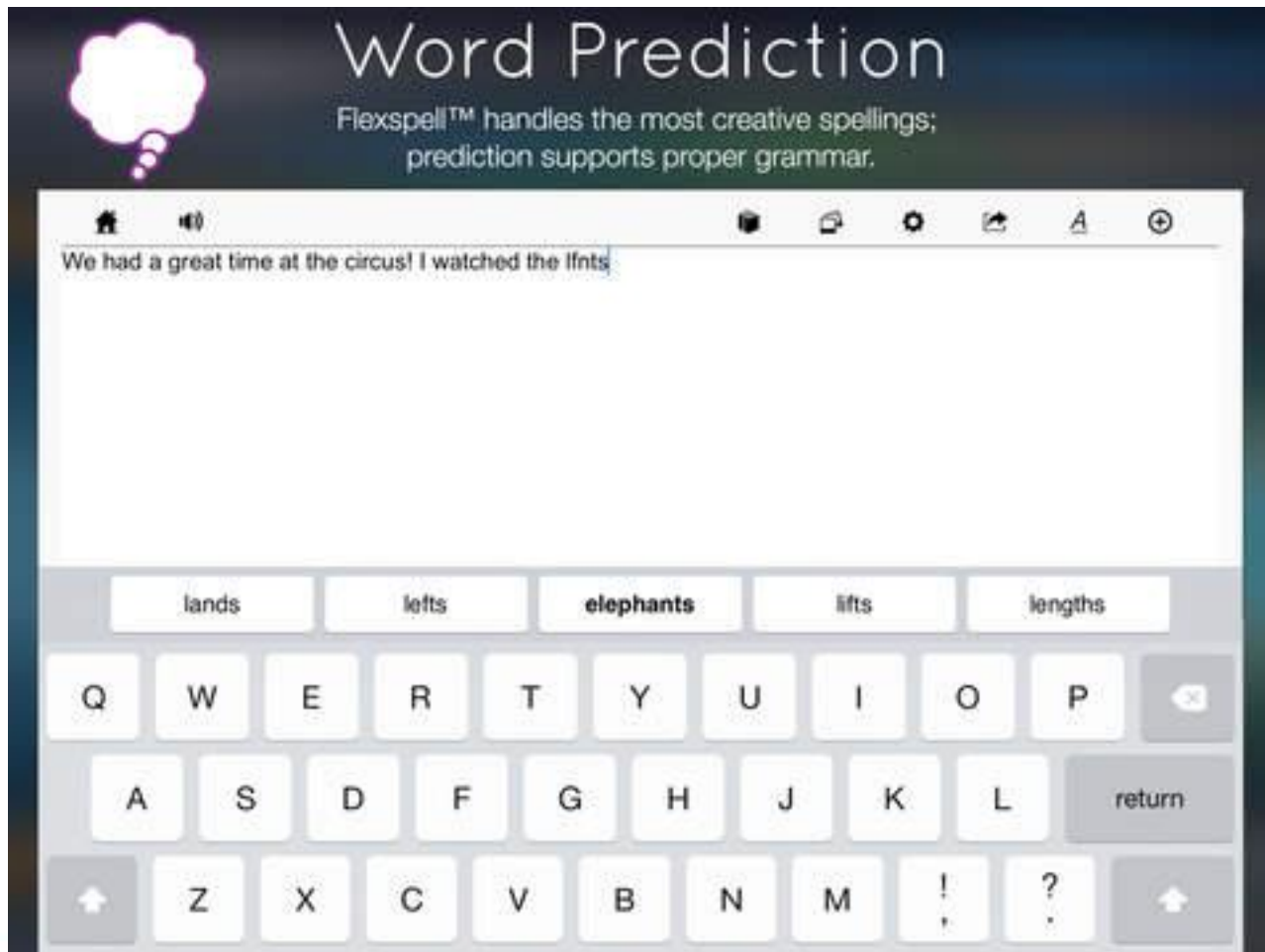

- Under settings you can change reader voice, change reader speed, make prediction preferences among other things – exploring this section is helpful.

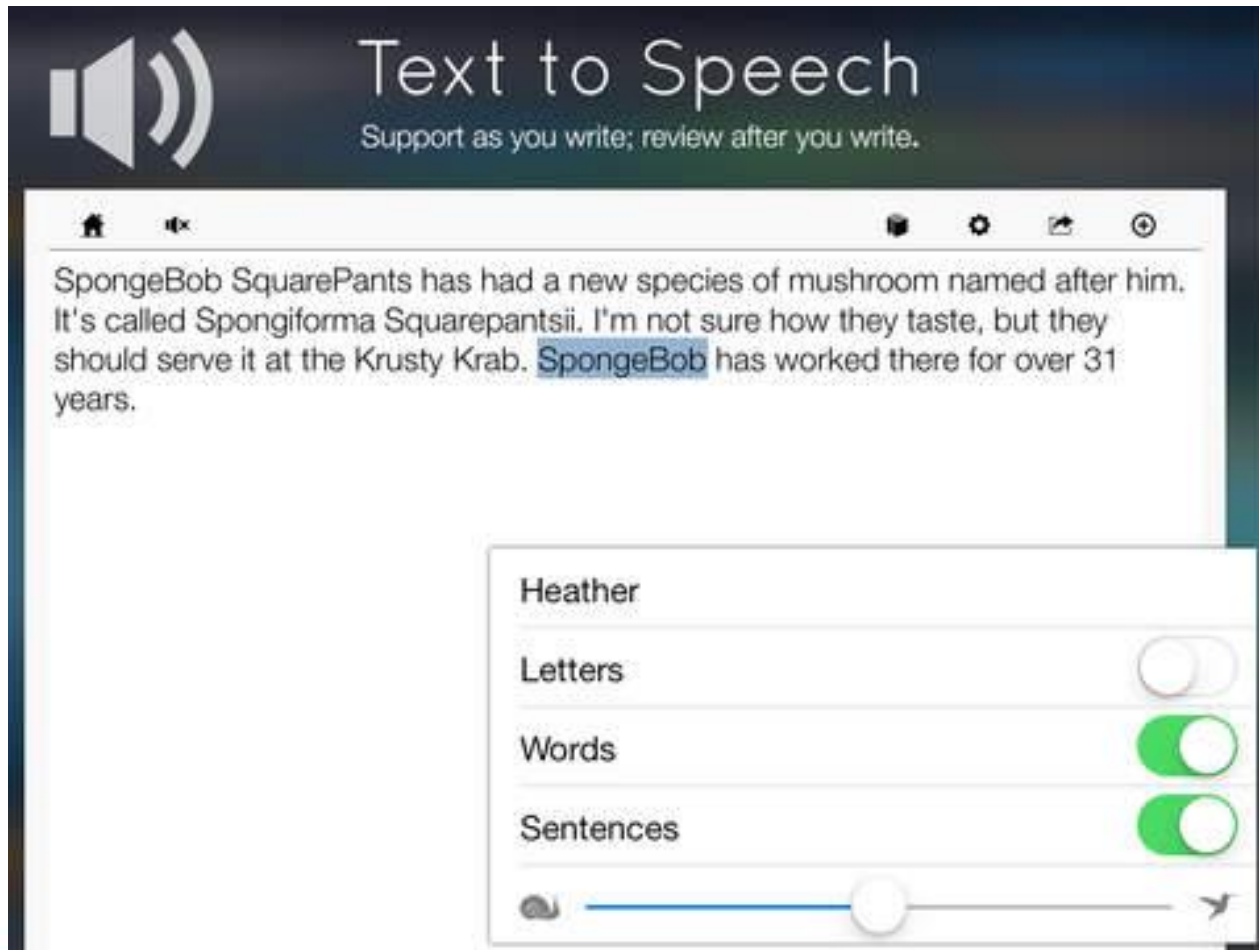
